Why Catholic: Nov. 2

Questions/Answers

1. In the Mass

- a. Jesus is symbolized by the bread and wine from the moment onward. Wrong, because Jesus is not symbolized by the bread and wine-they become him.
- **b.** Jesus is spiritually present when the community gathers in prayer under the leadership of the priest and ceases to be spiritually present when the priest leaves the sanctuary.

Wrong, because Jesus is more than just spiritually present during Mass and because he remains present in the consecrated elements until they cease to look like bread and wine. The priest's presence in the sanctuary isn't necessary.

- **c.** Jesus is physically present along with the bread and wine once the consecration has occurred. Wrong, because, although physically present, Jesus is not present with the bread and the wine. They cease to be present after the consecration. This is the heresy of consubstantiation or impanation.
- **D.** Jesus is present, and the bread and wine are not present, after the consecration. Correct, because the bread and wine cease to be present in their essence or substance after the consecration. Only Jesus is present. though the mere appearances of bread and wine remain.
- **e.** None of the above. Wrong, because 1d is correct.
