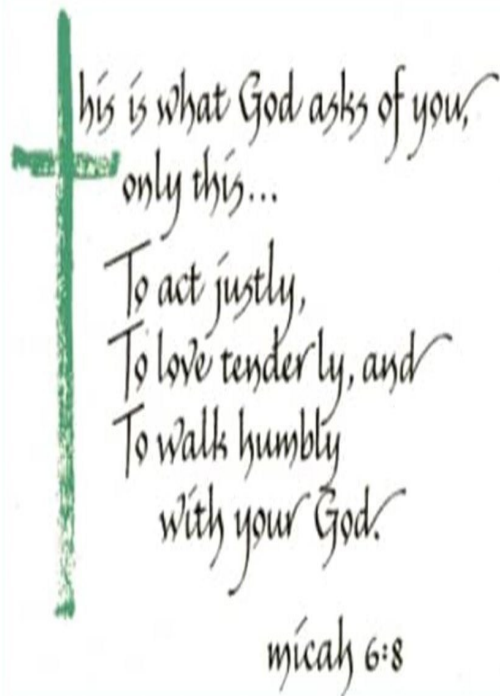

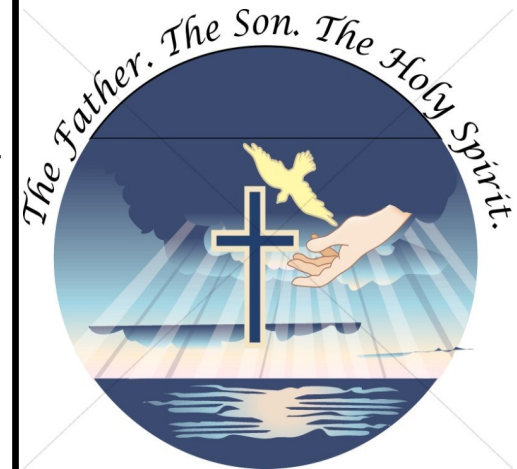

Why Catholic: May 31 Most Holy Trinity

As we celebrate the mystery of the Holy Trinity let's look at the Mystery of the Holy Trinity—The revelation of God as three distinct persons in one essence (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit).

Catholics believe in monotheism—there is only one God. However, this one God is a communion of three Persons:

* **The Father:** The ultimate source and creator of all things.

* **The Son:** Eternally begotten of the Father, who became man (the Incarnation) to redeem humanity.

* **The Holy Spirit:** The eternal bond of love that proceeds from the Father and the Son, acting as the Church's guide and sanctifier.

* Divine relationship, community, and the inner life of God.

* Meditate on the relational nature of God and review the Church's teachings on how the Trinity operates in our daily prayers.

The Real Presence in the Eucharist (Corpus Christi)

* The Feast of Corpus Christi immediately follows Trinity

Sunday, shifting focus to the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

* The Paschal mystery made present, thanksgiving, and communal worship.

The Trinity isn't just an abstract concept; it is considered the foundational core of Catholic life. Because God exists as a community of Persons, God is inherently a relationship of love. Catholics are baptized in the name of these three Persons.
