

**Lent**

Our Lenten journey of conversion begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18, 2026 and ends with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 3, 2026, the Catholic Church calls all Catholics to a deeper spirit of penance, fasting, almsgiving and prayer, "which express conversion in relation to oneself, to God, and to others" (Catechism of the Catholic Church).

**Lenten Regulations**

**Fasting:** On Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. This includes everyone from 18-59. This means having one regular meal + two small ones that equal no more than the regular meal..

**Abstinence:** Abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. Abstinence from meat is required by all who are 14 and older.
