Can you spend time with Jesus on the First Wednesday?

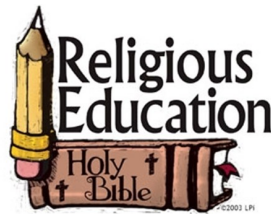
Needed: 3:30—4:00, 5:00 —
