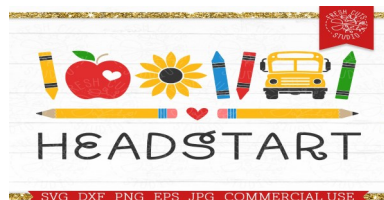
**OCIA:** Order of Christian Initiation for Adults.
