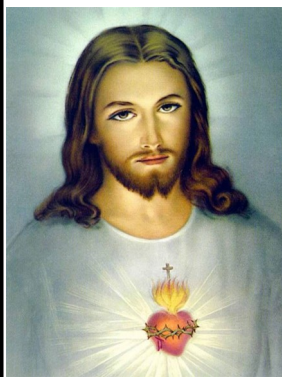

**Why Catholic: June 13**



As many of you have noticed in the bulletin, our monthly collections are showing a deficit compared to last year's funds. To address this

concern, we've been exploring various options to help parish members make consistent monthly contributions and improve our situation. However, we've found that many options charge a 3 to 4% fee, which ultimately results in a loss of funds for our parish.

The best solution at this point is for you to set up automatic payments directly to the church from your bank. This approach offers several advantages, including saving time, increasing simplicity, stabilizing the budget, and reducing the time required for our accounting. By implementing this change, we can make the process more convenient and consistent for both you and the parish. Also, when you attend Mass in another parish or on vacation this protects and secures that we obtain the funds.

This is simply an overall budgeting improvement that benefits both you and your church. Parishioners, this small change can make a significant difference in reducing our deficit.
